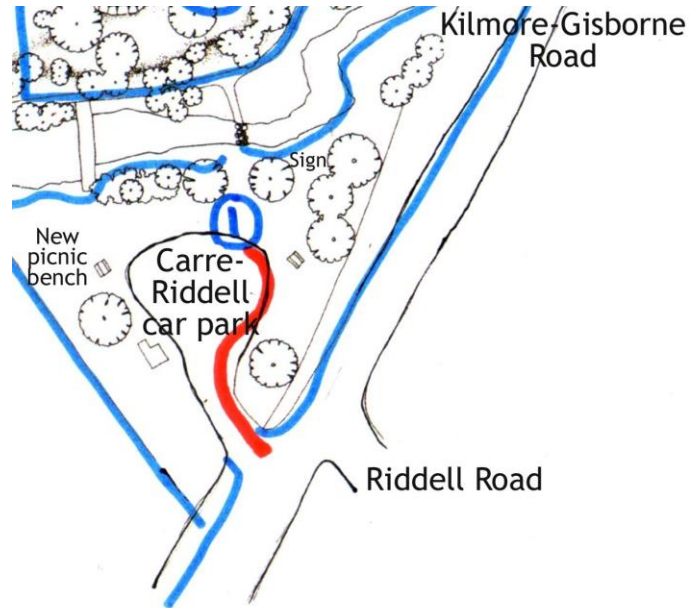




Greening of Riddell



Zone 1 – area south of the creek and surrounding the Carre-Riddell car park and the recently demolished toilet block. This area is in the process of changing Committee of Management responsibility. As it is DELWP crown land it will become Parks Victoria managed land. Macedon Ranges Shire Council (MRSC) may continue to mow it and provide some infrastructure, they installed 2 small picnic tables in 2007. Greening of Riddell manages the plantings and builds some of the infrastructure, and Melbourne Water are responsible for bed and banks of streams.

In 2018 Greening of Riddell (GoR) replaced the interpretative sign and built a new picnic bench.

Actions

- Slash grass along road verge above wallaby grass slope.
- Bollard and rail barriers were erected in March 2009, repaired September 2019 by GoR, monitor into the future for damage.
- Phragmites reed beds are a source of community concern and can be slashed periodically to remove dead reeds. Cull elm suckers in reed bed.
- Melbourne Water has poisoned and removed the last willow tree. Continue to advocate for the replacement of the toilet block.
