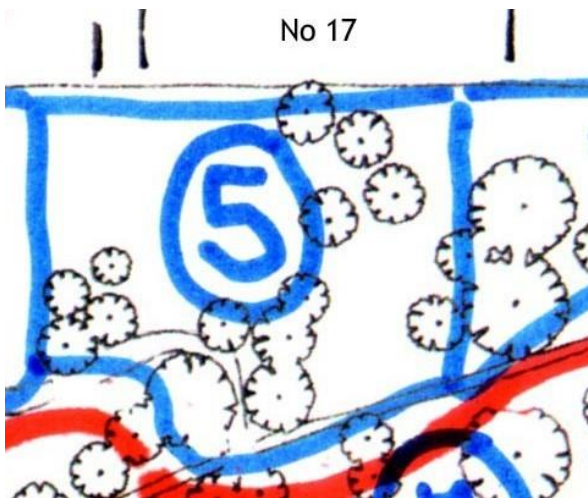


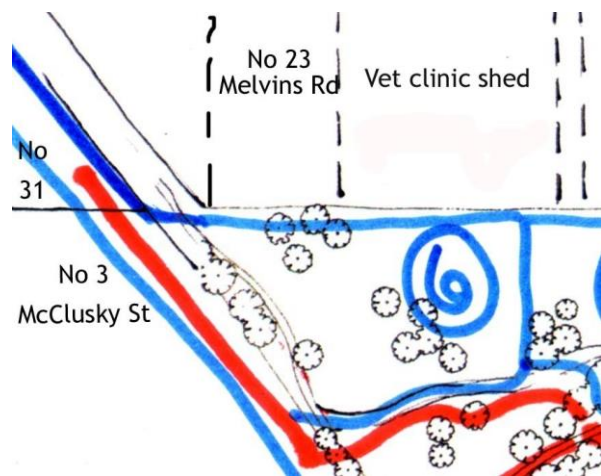


Greening of Riddell



Zone 5 Actions -

- Keep an eye out for Serrated Tussock, Chilean Needlegrass and Broom seedlings
- Spray or dig out Phalaris and Cocksfoot
- Clean up dropped branches from big Sugar Gum
- Avoid *Clematis microphylla* when mowing down hill of the vehicle access track.
- Recoat picnic bench with oil when necessary.



Zone 6 – Actions -

- Keep an eye out for Serrated Tussock
- Continue to mow around *Agave americana* to check its spread
- In spring/summer spray or dig out Chilean Needlegrass along the western fence of the Park. Check its spread from neighbouring properties.
- Remove *Amsinckia*—Ironweed from Melvins Road entrance
- Cut and reduce dead wattle trees but don't eradicate insect habitat
- Encourage growth of remnant Kangaroo Grass, reduce herbicide, hand weed and periodic burn
